Product Information

Weekly Produce Share - 30 boxes - A seasonal selection of fresh, clean, organic produce delivered weekly, May 8 through October 30 and every other week in November and December. Expect it to meet the needs of a household of 2 adults and 2 children. This is the most economical option per box, and our preference for simplicity. If a box every week is too much for you, try splitting or alternating weekly boxes with another small household.

Every - Other - Week Produce Share - 17 boxes - The same seasonal selection of clean, organic produce we pack in the weekly box, but delivered every-other-week, May - December. Meets the needs of small households who choose not to split a weekly share with another family. We are unable to change the dates of your delivery to accommodate vacations and special needs with the every-other-week share. If you would like this convenience, please sign up for the flex plan. E-O-W members pick up on EITHER "green" or "brown" weeks*.

Peak Season Share - 20 boxes - Weekly deliveries during the height of the Midwestern growing season: June 12 - October 23.

Flex Plan - Choose the weeks you wish to receive a box. Minimum number of boxes is 17. Cost is calculated per box. You must fill out the flex plan calendar (enclosed in this brochure or available on our website) and return it with sign up form. The flex plan allows members to change the dates of their delivery with 4 days notice to the farm.

Extended Season - 2 boxes - An extension of the regular CSA box. Similar to December boxes but larger and with a special surprise. First box delivered January 8, 2009; second on January 22, 2009.

Coffee Share - 19 deliveries - An every-other-week delivery of one or two pounds of whole bean, certified organic, fair trade Kickapoo coffee. Coffee is freshly roasted the day before delivery. "Roasters choice"- coffee varieties rotate weekly, Harmony Valley Blend is the most frequently delivered roast. Coffee is delivered on "brown weeks", the opposite week as fruit, for 19 weeks, May through January.

Fruit Program - An every-other-week box of certified organic fruit, sourced at its peak from the best fruit growing regions of North America. Sixteen deliveries: ten from June 19 through October 23, six from November 6 through January 22. Fruit is delivered on "green weeks", the opposite week as coffee.

NEW! Cheese Share Program - 19 deliveries - An every-other-week delivery of about 2.5 # of organic cheese including cheddar, colby, or mozzarella; a uniquely flavored vegetable cheese such as caramelized onion or pesto; and a specialty cow, sheep, or goat cheese. Cheese will be delivered May through January on "brown weeks," the same weeks as coffee deliveries.

Monthly Electronic Payment Plan

Should I need to terminate my membership mid-season, I agree to transfer my produce share to an individual of my choice and will give Harmony Valley 30 days written notice of this change. I understand that unless I communicate my desire to terminate my membership with Harmony Valley in December 2008, my membership will continue into 2009, and debits will continue to be made from my account beginning in January 2009, at the new rates for that year. Harmony Valley will notify members of the yearly rate changes in writing at least 30 days prior to taking effect (by December 15th). I have enclosed a voided, blank check to facilitate set up of the program.
